## Message from Fr. Pat

The Mass is the source and summit of our faith, it is the highest form of prayer that we can give to our God. As Catholics we are blessed that the Mass is being offered several times a week, and normally many times a day as well. In fact, you can visit the website [www.masstimes.org](http://www.masstimes.org) to find out where and when a Mass is being offered anywhere.

Since the Mass is considered the highest form of prayer, it is appropriate that there should be an intention for that prayer. Each Mass that is said has an intention, that the priest will focus the prayers of the Mass on this intention. Here at St. Joseph's we have five weekday Masses and two Sunday Masses; the two Sunday Masses on the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of the month is reserved for the intentions of the parish, all the other Masses are available to have the Mass focused on a personal intention.

These intentions can be for different things, like the repose of a deceased loved one, the healing of a person's illness, or even a birthday and anniversary. There is only one intention per Mass. If you are interested in having a Mass said for your intention, it is very simple, call or come to the parish office and Marge will help you setup on which Mass your intention will be offered. You may want an intention offered on a particular day that corresponds to a person death, their birth or an anniversary. The offering for a Mass intention is \$10.00.

### Vandalism Happens

One of the things that I learned after coming to St. Joseph parish, is that we have a problem with vandalism. The most recent act of vandalism happened last week, when someone tore down the flag pole in the front of the church that flew the Papal flag. The flag pole was found on the ground and the flag was missing. I was told that this was not the first time that the flags were targets of vandalism. Rather than put the pole and the flag back up, and wait for it to be vandalized again we are going to remove both flag poles and flags. We will have the American and Papal flag displayed in the church. We must accept, that because of our location and our ministry we will be continually targeted, we will just have to deal with each situation as it occurs, and find ways to protect church property.
