

Here is our parish budget for the coming year, as you can see, we have a deficit of \$63,865. This is primarily due to in the increase of our Property & Liability insurance increasing by \$65,463 from last year. The total premium is now \$126,142 of which we paid \$42,048 before the end of last year. Our checking and savings reserves balances starting this year is \$56,379 which brings our deficit down to \$7,486. Our offertory collections for last year were \$202,704. We had to use funds from savings to pay the \$80,000 deductible for the roof repair.

I received approval from the diocese to use money from the hurricane savings account to pay the remaining \$84.094 premium of the property & liability insurance. We will then replenish that savings account throughout the year to get it back to its former level.

We have work ahead of us to keep the parish financially stable. Our goal this year is to keep on track with budget, by working to reduce our expenses and to increase our income, which our upcoming stewardship program will help with.
