A Message from Fr. Pat

REBUILD AND GROW

As the Pastor, one of my goals is to grow St. Joseph parish, I call this the Rebuild and Grow initiative. There are two aspects of the initiative, the first is the number of registered parishioners that we have, and the second is the financial stability of the parish.

Currently we have 183 families registered in the parish, down from over 250 several years ago. The goal for Rebuild this year is to add 50 families to make our number of parish families 233; I have been told by parishioners that this is an achievable goal. I would be very happy if we could surpass this goal and come next June, we have 250 or more registered families.

At the center of the experience of being a parishioner at St. Joseph is participation at the Mass, and it is also what make our parish so attractive to visitors. It is widely accepted that elements that draw people to attend Mass is the quality of three things; Good Music, Good Preaching and Genuine Hospitality and I think we have all three here at St. Joseph.

So, I am asking everyone's assistance to reach out to former parishioners that you know, and invite them to come attend Mass at St. Joseph, to see what they are missing. We will be reporting on how we are doing with our efforts as the year goes on.

On the financial side, starting this fall we will begin a program called Amen Generosity. This program will help educate our parish on the relationship between our own spiritual growth and the financial support that is given to the mission of St. Joseph parish. This program has been used by many parishes in the diocese and is supported by Bishop Wack. I am looking for five parishioners to help me lead this effort, if you are interested, please contact me.

For Rebuild and Grow to be successful, we need all parishioners to actively help in getting families to join St. Joseph, and to be open to prayerfully discern their financial support of the parish.


