A Message from Fr. Pat...

Today we celebrate Catechetical Sunday, here is a definition of what catechesis is. "Catechesis is nothing other than the process of transmitting the Gospel, as the Christian community has received it, understands it, celebrates it, lives it and communicates it in many ways." (General Directory for Catechesis #105).

The theme of this year's Catechetical Sunday is
"Come to me all you who labor and are burdened"
Matthew 11:28

This year's theme reminds us of the invitation we receive from the Lord Jesus to follow Him and the promise that He doesn't want to add to our burdens; he wants to lighten them.

When we speak of catechesis we think of sacramental preparation, religious education at the elementary, high school, university and seminary levels, but it does not end there. As a follower of Jesus Christ and a faithful Catholic, we are called to lifelong catechesis; to allow us to be able to follow Jesus' commandment in Matthew 28:19-20

"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you."

We can only do this, if we are well formed through catechesis in God's Word and an understand of the teaching of the Catholic Church. It is my responsibility as your Pastor to provide you the opportunity of catechetical formation, but it is up to you to take advantage of it; to refer to the old saying, "you can lead a horse to water, but you can't make him drink".

To help you in your formation, in addition to programs here at St. Joseph, I will begin to share with you worthwhile sources for your formation. Starting this week, I want to suggest a book "Catching Fire Becoming Flame" by Fr. Albert Haase, OFM, Fr. Albert will be here at St. Joseph to lead a Lenten Mission, February 3rd through the 7th. His book is available on Amazon in either paperback or Kindle.
