

THE EUCHARIST AS REAL PRESENCE



Isn't the Eucharist just a symbol of Jesus?



No, the Eucharist is not merely a symbol of Jesus. Nor is Christ only spiritually present in some vague way in the bread and wine. At the Last Supper, Jesus took bread and wine and

said, "This is my body...This is my blood." When the priest at Mass recites Jesus' words at the moment of Consecration, the bread and wine on the altar are changed into Christ's Body and Blood. They are no longer bread and wine. When we are in the presence of the Eucharist, we are in the midst of the Real Presence of Jesus Christ. Indeed, this is the supreme gift Jesus gives us; the gift of his very self, the Real Presence of his Body and Blood in the Eucharist!

In this Sunday's second reading, St Paul points to our identity as *copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel.* (Eph 3:6) Each of us finds our deepest eternal

identity in our destiny as children of God who are called on mission through the Church. Have we found our place as *Co-Partners*?
