

## A Message from Fr. Pat.....

Just a reminder I have only been a priest for seven months, so I am on a journey of learning of what it means to be a priest and a pastor. I am an advocate of promoting Mass intentions, to offer the Mass for a passed loved one or a personal intention. I just learned something while visiting some parishes in New Orleans, that we are not following the requirement laid out in the code of canon law. Specifically, that a Mass on Sunday and holy day of obligation must be offered for the needs of the people of our parish.

The code of canon law is the document that governs all aspects of the Catholic church.

Canon Law is a code of ecclesiastical laws governing the Catholic Church. In the Latin or Western Church, the governing code is the 1983 Code of Canon Law, a revision of the 1917 Code of Canon Law.

Here are the specific canons regarding to Masses being offered for the people of the parish.

Can. 534 §1. After a pastor has taken possession of his parish, he is obliged to apply a Mass for the people entrusted to him on each Sunday and holy day of obligation in his diocese. If he is legitimately impeded from this celebration, however, he is to apply it on the same days through another or on other days himself.

- §2. A pastor who has the care of several parishes is bound to apply only one Mass for the entire people entrusted to him on the days mentioned in §1.
- §3. A pastor who has not satisfied the obligation mentioned in §§1 and 2 is to apply as soon as possible as many Masses for the people as he has omitted.

So based on this information I have been made aware of, we will be reworking the calendar of Mass intentions. Marge may be reaching out to you to reschedule your Mass intention.

# THE EUCHARIST AS REAL PRESENCE



Did the original hearers think Jesus was really claiming to give us his Body and Blood to eat and drink?

Yes. In the Bread of Life discourse, Jesus says, "I am the bread of life" (John 6:35), and makes it clear that he is not speaking in a vague, figurative way: "The bread which I shall give for the life of the world *is my flesh*" (John 6:51, emphasis added).

The people listening were shocked at this. They said, "How can this man give us his flesh to eat?" (John 6:52). Notice that they didn't think Jesus was speaking metaphorically. They understood Jesus very well. They knew that he was speaking realistically here, and that's why they were horrified and couldn't accept what he was saying.


