

THE EUCHARIST AS REAL PRESENCE



Isn't God present everywhere? How is the Eucharist different?

God is present to his people in many ways. In the most foundational way, God is omnipresent-present everywhere-by virtue of his power in holding everything in existence. The stars, this book in your hand, even your very life would cease to exist if God did not keep it in existence moment by moment by his power.

But God is even closer to us in profound spiritual ways. Christ is present in a special way in the poor, in his Word, in the sacraments, and in the prayer of two or more who gather in his name.

Even more, however, Jesus is uniquely present in the Eucharist. For the Eucharist is the very Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ. Through the Eucharist, "Christ, God and man, makes himself wholly and entirely present." Therefore, when we encounter the Eucharist, we encounter the same Jesus who walked the streets of Galilee two thousand years ago, made present to us now under the sacramental signs of bread and wine.
