



THE EUCHARIST AS HOLY COMMUNION


What are the fruits of the Holy Communion?

A Message from Fr. Pat

I received a call from Bishop Bill on Tuesday letting me know that he has assigned me as Pastor of St. Joseph Parish. Now you may say, wait a second aren't you already Pastor of the Parish? Technically, I am not, I am the Parochial Administrator not the Pastor. The bishop assigns a priest to be the Parochial Administrator of parish for a time until he is confident in naming that priest Pastor.

The Pastor and Administrator perform the same job, but the Pastor has Canonical rights that the Administrator does not. Most important is the Pastor is named to a six -year term, that is renewable for another six. The Administrator serves at the pleasure of the bishop, for however long he wants to keep him at the parish and can remove him at anytime for any reason. For a Pastor to be removed, the bishop must present a strong case with evidence of why the priest should no longer be the Pastor.

My desire is that while I am fulfilling the ministry of a Priest, I want my ministry to be at St. Joseph parish. After I am installed as Pastor my six-year term starts, and after that time, I have the option to renew for another six years. That's twelve years from now and I will be 78; Bishop Bill knows my level of commitment to St. Joseph.

So sometime this summer at one of our Sunday Masses, in the presence of the bishop or his designate, I will sign the documents that will make me Pastor of St. Joseph Parish.




