Deluxe Picnic Beans

	Sauce
1 can kidney beans	3/4 cup brown sugar
1 can butter beans	1/4 tsp. dry mustard
1 can lima beans	1/2 cup vinegar
1 large can pork and beans	1/2 cup catsup
1 lb. Hamburger, browned	
1/2 lb. Diced bacon, fried	
2 cloves garlic, minced	
2 Onions Minced	

Drain beans and put in casserole dish. Add hamburger, bacon, garlic and onions. Stir to blend well. Stir together sauce ingredients. Add to bean mixture. Bake one hour at 350 degrees, Also works great in slow cooker.

THE EUCHARIST AS HOLY COMMUNION

How often should I receive?

If we have the proper dispositions, we are encouraged to receive every time we participate in the Mass. At minimum, we should receive once a year during the Easter season. But it is recommended that we receive every Sunday, on feast days, and if possible, even daily. A lay person who has already received Communion may receive it again on the same day but only within a Mass in which he or she is participating.
