Ambrosia Cake

Recipe by Martin De Porres Lewis

1 pkg. Yellow pudding cake mix 1/2 c orange-pineapple juice 1 c. coconut 1/2 c. pecan pieces 1/2 c chopped maraschino cherries 4 oz. crushed pineapple with juice

Frosting 3/4 c sugar Dash of salt 2 T. flour 1 c. orange-pineapple juice 1 T. lemon juice 2 T. margarine 1 c. coconut 1/2 c sliced maraschino cherries 1/2 c pecan pieces 4 oz crushed pineapple with juice

Mix cake following package directions, except use half a cup orangepineapple juice instead of water. Add coconut, pecan pieces, cherries and half a can of crushed pineapple with juice. Grease bottom and sides of tube pan and bake according to directions on cake box. Frosting In saucepan mix sugar, salt and flour. Stir in one cup orangepineapple juice and lemon juice. Stir over low heat until it thickens, Stir in margarine, coconut, cherries, pecan pieces and half can of crushed pineapple with juices. Pour over cake


