Feast Day of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church, May 20th. 2024



Why do we celebrate Mary, as Mother of the Church?

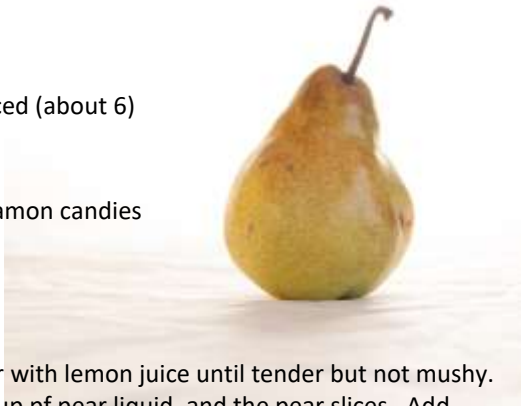
The theological roots of this title go back to the early Church. The Fathers of the Church, holy and studious bishops of the first centuries, often spoke of Mary as the New Eve. Just as the Woman Eve was “the mother of all the living” (Gen. 3:20), the Woman Mary was mother of all those living in Christ. In Revelation 12:17, St. John says that the Woman’s offspring are “those who keep the commandments of God and bear testimony to Jesus. The popularity of the specific expression “Mother of the Church” grew especially in the 20th and 21st centuries. In 2018 Pope Francis added a feast day under this title for the Monday following the solemnity of Pentecost considered the birthday of the Church.

Rosy Pear Pie

- 6 cups fresh pears sliced (about 6)
- 3 cups water
- 2 tbs lemon juice
- 1 jar (1 ¾ oz) red cinnamon candies
- 3 tbs. cornstarch
- ¼ cup cold water
- 1 cup sugar



Simmer pears in water with lemon juice until tender but not mushy. Drain, reserving one cup of pear liquid, and the pear slices. Add candies to pear liquid and simmer until candies have dissolved. Blend cornstarch and cold water until smooth. Stir into cinnamon mixture, cooking over low heat, stirring constantly until thickened and clear. Remove from heat, stir in sugar until dissolved, then add pears and cool. Heat oven to 400 degrees. Pour cooled pear mixture into pastry lined pan. Apply a lattice top, and brush with milk and sugar. Bake 35 to 40 minutes.
