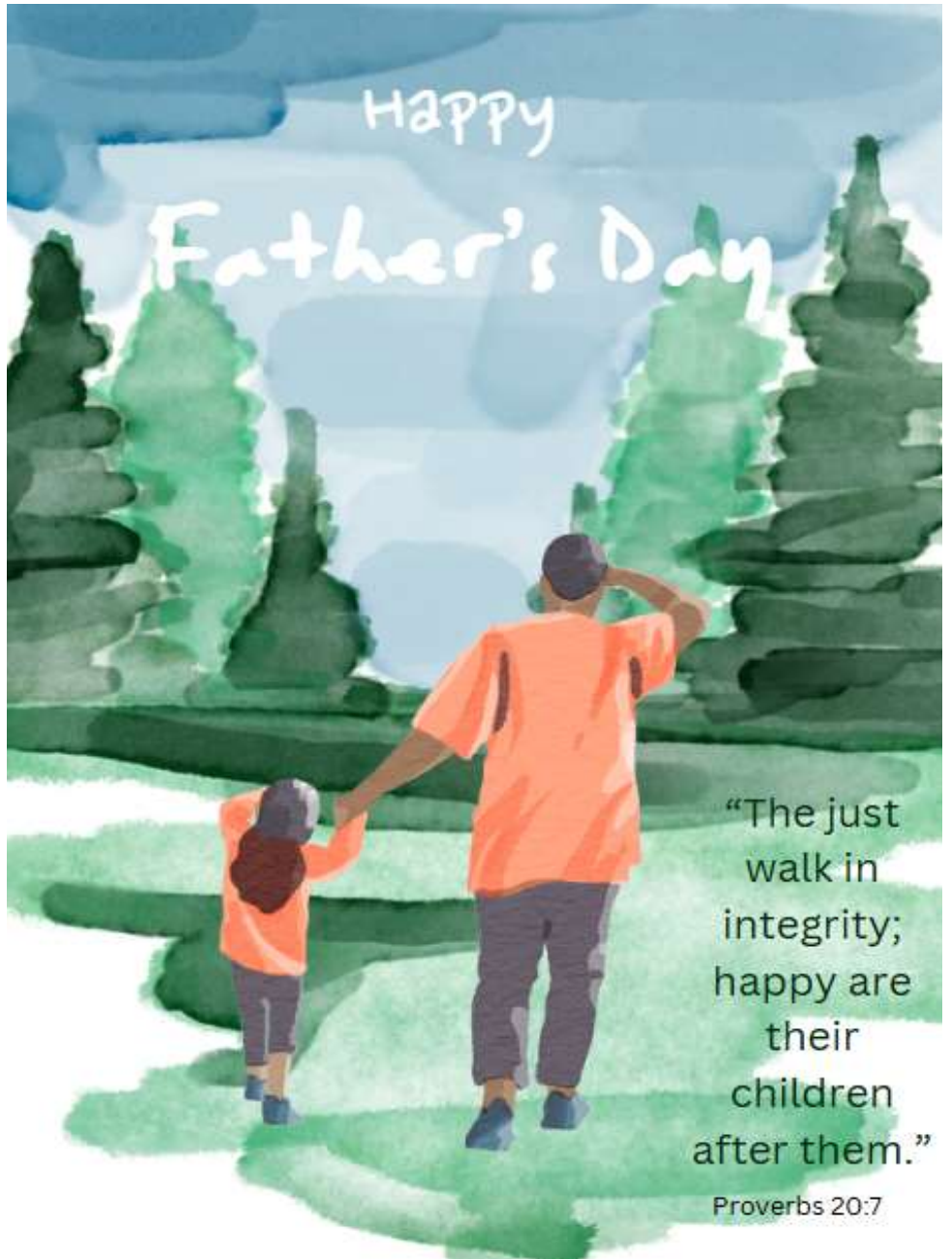

Can I receive communion in these other non-Catholic churches?

Because the Eastern Churches, through apostolic succession, still have the priesthood, the sacraments, and the Eucharist, communion is possible and even encouraged "given suitable circumstances and the approval of Church authority."

But since the ecclesial communities rooted in the Reformation have not maintained the Sacrament of Holy Orders and the full reality of the Eucharistic mystery, "Eucharistic intercommunion with these communities is not possible" (CCC 1400). The sad realities of division within Christ's Body urge us all to pray that the full unity of all Christian believers may one day be restored (see CCC 1398).
