Are there any circumstances in which Holy Communion may be given to other Christians?

Catholic ministers may give Holy Communion to members of those Eastern churches that are not in full communion with the Catholic Church but possess the sacraments, the priesthood, and apostolic succession. If they ask for it of their own accord and have the required disposition. Members of other ecclesial communities (those derived from the Protestant Reformation) may be given Holy Communion only in grave situations, if they ask for it, have the required disposition, and exhibit evidence of believing what the Church teaches about the Eucharist.

RECIPE CORNER

**Nana's Meatloaf**

From Carmen Rizzo

Ingredients

- 1-1/2 lbs. ground beef
- 1 egg
- 1 small onion chopped
- 1 cup of milk
- 1 cup of dried breadcrumbs
- 2 tablespoon brown sugar
- 2 tablespoons prepared mustard
- 1/3 cup ketchup
- Salt and pepper to taste



Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

In a large bowl combine beef, onion, egg, milk and breadcrumbs. Season with salt and pepper to taste and place in a lightly greased 9x5 inch loaf pan.

In another small bowl combine the brown sugar, mustard and ketchup. Mix well and pour over the meatloaf.

Bake for 1 hour.
