#### THE EUCHARIST AS HOLY COMMUNION

Do other non-Catholic churches have the Eucharist?

Some do, and some do not.

First, let's consider the Eastern Churches that are not in full communion with the Catholic Church (for example, the Orthodox Churches). Though they are separated from the Catholic Church, they still have apostolic succession – the handing on of authority from the Apostles to their successors (the bishops) throughout the centuries by the laying on of hands. Therefore, these Churches do possess real sacraments, the priesthood, and the Eucharist, which still joins them to us?

Second, the ecclesial communities that are rooted in the Protestant Reformation are separated from the Catholic Church, and they "have not preserved the proper reality of the Eucharistic mystery in its fullness, especially because of the absence of the sacraments of the Holy Orders. Without proper apostolic succession (which is necessary for the valid ordination of bishops and priests), these communities are unable to celebrate the Eucharist. Nevertheless, when they commemorate the Lord's death and resurrection in the Holy Supper," they "profess that it signifies life in communion with Christ and awaits his coming in glory."
