



The faithful in the United States may receive the Eucharist on the tongue or in the hand.

The Church teaches that the faithful have the right to receive Holy Communion on the tongue. But if a communicant, by his choice, desires to receive in the hand, Holy Communion may be administered in the hand where the bishops' conference has given permission. In the dioceses in the United States, the bishop allow this.

In Matthew 25:31-46, three days before Our Lord and Savior was crucified, Jesus recorded a passage titled The Judgement of the Nations. Often-times the most important things are said near the end. Here Jesus tells us the importance of performing the six Corporal Works of Mercy. These include feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, welcoming the stranger, comforting the ill, clothing the naked and lastly visiting those in prison. He states these six works three times each in that short Scripture reading.

The timing of this passage in Jesus' life on earth, the repetition, the specificity of the works and the eternal consequences should get anyone's attention. All are easily accessible. In the past, visiting a prisoner in the Pensacola area was not very accessible. That is no longer the case. We now have a well-developed Kolbe Prison Ministries of Pensacola that ministers.
