EUCCHARISTIC DEVOTION OUTSIDE OF MASS

What is the purpose of the tabernacle?

The tabernacle was originally intended as a dignified place to reserve the sacred Hosts that were to be brought to the sick and dying outside of Mass. It became a place for the faithful to pray and adore Christ present in the Eucharist. It is a safe place to store consecrated Hosts, protecting them from being desecrated. The law of the Church states that the tabernacle is to be "immovable, made of solid and opaque materials, and locked so that the danger of profanation may be entirely avoided"

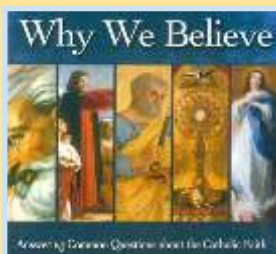
