EUCHARISTIC DEVOTION OUTSIDE OF MASS

How should we show reverence to Jesus and worship him in the Eucharist?

We show our faith in the Eucharist not only during the Liturgy but also outside of Mass by giving the Sacrament of the Eucharist the worship that is due to God alone, for Christ's Real Presence remains in the consecrated Hosts. We express this worship in many ways: by bowing deeply or genuflecting (kneeling) before the tabernacle which houses Christ's Real Presence under the species of bread and wine, by reserving the consecrated Hosts with the greatest care and reverence, by exposing the sacred Hosts for the faithful to venerate in Eucharistic Adoration and by bearing the sacred Hosts in solemn Eucharistic processions.

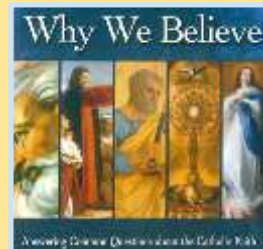
