## EUCHARISTIC DEVOTION OUTSIDE OF MASS



## What is the difference between Adoration and Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament?

Eucharistic Adoration refers to the worship of our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. We express our adoration in many ways; genuflecting toward the tabernacle that contains the Blessed Sacrament, kneeling before the tabernacle, and sitting in silent prayer before Christ's Real Presence in the Eucharist. The Church encourages us to male a frequent visits to adore the Blessed Sacrament kept in the tabernacle.

*Exposition* of the Blessed Sacrament is a more focused form of Eucharistic Adoration that is part of the Church's liturgical life. It is a solemn rite in which the sacred Host is displayed for public worship. This can take place in a simple way by opening the tabernacle doors or in it's fullest form when the consecrated Host is placed in a sacred vessel called a *monstrance* (based on the Latin word *monstrare*, which means "to show"), so that it can be easily seen and adored.

## CATHOLIC BLACK HISTORY MONTH

## ST. MARTIN DE PORRES Feast Day : November 3rd

He was born in Lima, Peru, the illegitimate son of a Spanish knight, John de Porres, and a freed Panamanian slave named Anna. In 1594, Martin became a Dominican lay brother in Lima and served in various menial offices. Outside of the monastery he became known for his care of the poor and the sick. Martin founded an orphanage and ministered to African slaves brought to Lima. He was aided by St. Rose of Lima, who respected his penances and labors. Martin experienced many mystical gifts, including bilocation and aerial flights. When he was dying in Rosary Convent on November 3, the viceroy, the count of Chichon, knelt by his bed, seeking Martin's blessing. Martin, who is the patron of interracial justice, was canonized by Blessed Pope John XXIII (r. 1958-1963) in 1962.
