

THE EUCHARIST AS HOLY COMMUNION

Why is the priest the only one who can celebrate Mass?

As Pope Francis once said, "The Eucharist isn't a reunion of friends who come to pray and eat bread and wine. The Eucharist is fundamentally priestly." At the Last Supper, Jesus commanded the Apostles to celebrate the Eucharist: "Do this in memory of me." It was then that they were ordained as priests, given power to offer the sacrifice of the Lord's Supper and confect the Eucharist.

That priestly office has been handed down from the Apostles to their successors, the bishops, throughout the ages through the laying on of hands in the Sacrament of Holy Orders. The bishops share their consecration and mission with the priests who, through the Sacrament of Holy Orders, become coworkers with their bishop in the mission Christ entrusted to the Apostles. It is in the celebration of the Eucharist that they exercise their priestly office most fully, acting in the person of Christ (*in persona Christi*), offering the sacrifice of the Mass, and confecting the Eucharist, changing the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ.
