#### THE EUCHARIST AS HOLY COMMUNION

#### What should I do to prepare for Mass?

It's important not just to walk into Mass as if you were attending an ordinary event, but to prepare your heart and mind to encounter God himself in the sacred Liturgy. We need to transition from our normal routines in the world to the sacredness of the Mass. One way to prepare for Mass is to take time beforehand to prayerfully review the readings from the :Liturgy of the Word. We can do this at home or at church. We can also arrive at church early so that we have some time to quiet ourselves and pray before Mass begins. This is not the time to be talking to people around us. We want to prepare our hearts to encounter God. At a minimum, we are required to fast one hour before we received Holy Communion and to enter into a spirit of prayer and recollection.
