- The person has a max of 5 minutes to speak
- Begin by saying their name and whether they are a parishioner or a former parishioner.
- Say something positive about St. Joseph.
- If they are a former parishioner, why did they leave.
- State 1 Issue, concern, or a suggestion to improve in the parish

The moderators may ask a clarifying question
There will not be a response to what is said during the session, everything said will be recorded and written down to address in the future.
