That we may hear the teaching of Jesus and give as did the widow, willing to sacrifice from our livelihood with great trust and love, we pray....

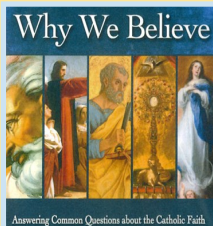
