

Gospel Reflection from the Seasonal Missalette

May 25 Sixth Sunday of Easter

Two major transitions are drawing near. Next week we will celebrate the Ascension, when Jesus leaves the earth and ascends to the Father. Two weeks from now we will celebrate Pentecost, when the Holy Spirit descends from the Father and the Son to remain with us forever. In today's Gospel, Jesus looks past his own death and resurrection to prepare his disciples for these transitions, for the time when he would no longer physically accompany them. He assures them that if they love him and keep his word, he and the Father will make their dwelling with them. And he explains that the Holy Spirit will continue to enlighten and guide them. The first reading gives us a glimpse of this. In a scene that occurs only about twenty years after that first Pentecost, the Holy Spirit enables the leaders of the church to discern that only a minimal number of Jewish traditions need be observed by Gentiles baptized in Christ. May we continue to look to the Holy Spirit, whom Jesus promises today, to relieve "any burden beyond these necessities" (Acts 15:28) in accepting all those who come to us with a sincere heart.
