

Gospel Reflection from the Seasonal Missalette

August 17 20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

How do you think Jeremiah felt after the princes of Judah threw him into a cistern and left him to die? As death by starvation came closer, did he regret speaking out in God's name? Clearly he did not, for after he is rescued and after today's first reading ends, he continues to warn the people of God's wrath. Jeremiah is ready to pay any price for speaking the truth. Jesus is too. He realizes that preaching about a kingdom in which the first will be last, the lofty will be thrown down from their thrones, and the poor and the persecuted will be the ones to inherit it is divisive. But this is why he has come. That the message is divisive and leads to persecution is not a sign that it should be silenced—just the opposite. Therefore, he welcomes the blazing fire, the divided households, the baptism that will be his death on the cross. These are signs that he is accomplishing his mission. It is our turn now to preach his message and face opposition. But we do so knowing that as "the leader and perfecter of faith," Jesus is our model as we "persevere in running the race" to that kingdom (Hebrews 12:1–2). Have you spoken up for Sunday 8/17/25 justice, truth, or your faith when you know it will be divisive? When do you plan to do so?




