

# Gospel Reflection from the Seasonal Missalette

# August 31 **22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time**

Jesus loves to tell parables about banquets and feasts, doesn't he? In the one we hear today, a guest takes a prominent seat at the table, only to be directed, embarrassingly, to the lowest place instead. Jesus praises the guest who sits humbly and then is invited to a higher position. He has a lesson to the host as well: Do not invite those who will repay you by inviting you to their own feasts, but the poor and forgotten, who have no way to repay you. "You will be repaid," Jesus concludes, in a much better way: "at the resurrection of the righteous" (Luke 14:14). Jesus invites us all to the heavenly banquet, an offer we have no ability to return in kind. Or do we? Recall that Jesus teaches that what we do for the least of our brothers and sisters we do for him. Therefore, we repay him by feeding and clothing and visiting and caring for the Christ in those who cannot personally repay us. In lavishing our prosperity on those in need, we invite Christ to a banquet.

When you give yourself to someone in need, do you feel your reward in your heart? What will you do this week for someone in need?

"My child, conduct your affairs with humility, and you will be loved, more than a giver of gifts. Humble yourself the more, the greater you are, and you will find favor with God"

The readings on Sunday point us to the virtue of humility. In the Gospel Acclamation, we hear the words of Jesus to "take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart. In the Gospel, Jesus tells a parable of how we should take the lowest place in order to eventually find our higher calling. We know that meek is not weak. As exemplified by the countless women and men who followed Jesus to their martyr's death, humility requires us to be unafraid as we place our trust fully in God and give him all the glory by our radical faithfulness. As the prophet Sirach promises, then *you will be loved*. Will you and I humble ourselves to more fully know the merciful embrace of God's love?
