I am a Pensacola native and seminarian for the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee in my fourth year of formation, and I have never won the lottery, because I never play it. I add that last bit because my family and doctors remind me constantly that if I never ask for a kidney donation, I'm guaranteed never to get it.

So here I am, in what is a rather uncomfortable situation for myself, making it known that

I AM IN KIDNEY FAILURE
a three-times-a-week dialysis patient, and most importantly,
IN NEED OF A KIDNEY TRANSPLANT

I realize that is quite a big ask, and of course not everyone is capable, but if you are able and so moved by the Spirit it would be a wonderful act of charity and a life-changing gift for me. Scanning the QR code or following the web address will take you to a mini-site that include my bio and, more importantly, all the answers to frequently asked questions about kidney donation (spoiler: my insurance pays for everything medical-related).

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Soon our diocese will take up the Collection for the Church in Latin America. For more than 50 years, this collection has given Catholics in the United States an opportunity to share faith in unity with our brothers and sisters in Christ throughout Latin America and the Caribbean islands.

Through the Collection for the Church in Latin America, Catholics in the United States can express a closer unity with and love for their brothers and sisters in Central and South America and the Caribbean islands. This unity was fully expressed in autumn 2024, when Catholics from around the world gathered for an International Eucharistic Congress in Quito, Ecuador, to celebrate the country's 150th anniversary of its consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Using funds received from the Collection for the Church in Latin America, the Archdiocese of Quito welcomed thousands from around the world—including a delegation of Catholics from the United States led by Bishop Andrew Cozzens—to pray together, encounter the love of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, and share their faith. When you participate in the collection at your parish, you support special events such as the Eucharistic Congress as well as the ongoing work of forming catechists, supporting vocations to priesthood and religious life, and implementing family ministries throughout Latin America.

Our diocese takes up this collection on the weekend of August 10th, 2025. Please be generous toward this collection. Consider giving at Mass or through your parish's online giving platform.
