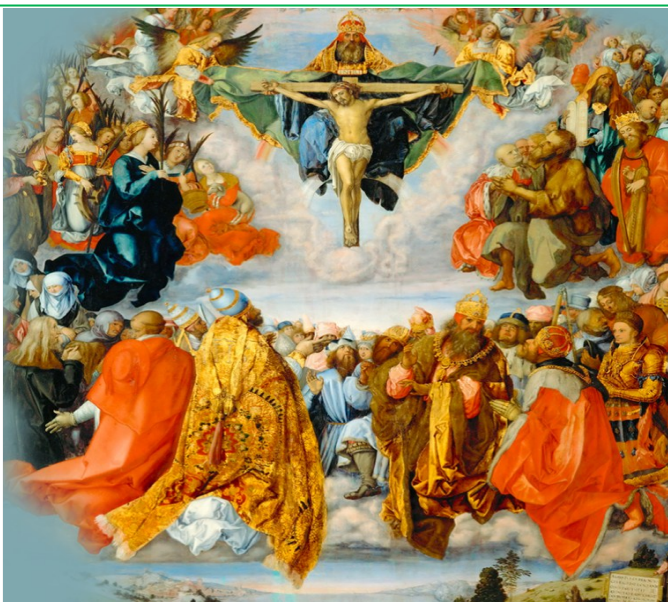

What is All Saints Day? November 2

All Saints Day honors the saints in Heaven – those who have been recognized by the Church as saints, as well as those who have not been canonized. The feast was established in Rome as a result of the emperor's giving of the Pantheon (the temple to all the gods) to the Church and its dedication to St. Mary and All the Martyrs. This followed the principle, "Christus vincit! Christus regnat! Christus imperat!" (Christ conquers, Christ reigns, Christ commands). Thus, throughout the Mediterranean many churches have been built over pagan sites, sanctifying them for Christ. The Church celebrates All Saints Day on November 1.

OUTREACH PRIEST

Father Fabian C. Anibueze

Father Fabian C. Anibueze was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Enugu, Nigeria, in 2011. After serving in various pastoral and administrative roles there, he pursued advanced studies in Rome, earning a doctorate in Christian and classical letters from the Pontifical Salesian University. His time in Europe also provided pastoral experiences in Italy, Germany, and Switzerland, and opened doors to serve in the United States — enriching his multicultural perspective and expanding his outreach to diverse communities. Fr. Anibueze is multilingual, speaking English, Italian, German, and Spanish, with scholarly proficiency in Latin and classical Greek. Since January 2024, he has served as a formator and professor of Church history, historical theology, and Latin at St. Vincent de Paul Regional Seminary in Boynton Beach, Florida. Passionate about priestly formation and global mission, Fr. Anibueze is honored to collaborate with Cross Catholic Outreach in bringing faith, education, and hope to the poor.

This official Catholic ministry was founded to link parishes in the U.S. with priests, religious brothers and sisters, and laypeople working in Church missions overseas.
